

Mount Lindesay Highway Upgrade Camp Cable Road to Tamborine/Johanna Street Intersection Jimboomba - Start of Major Construction

January 2020

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is delivering a Queensland Government funded \$20 million highway upgrade project on the Mount Lindesay Highway at Jimboomba.

SEE Civil Pty Ltd has been appointed to construct the project, which will begin in January 2020 and continue until early 2021 (weather and site conditions permitting).

Project works will include:

- two new lanes and a bridge northbound over Jimboomba Creek to provide improved flood immunity
- widening and upgrading to the existing highway to provide two southbound lanes
- relocated and upgraded bus stops at Camp Cable Road, connected by pedestrian links to the signals to provide safe public transport access
- an upgraded left-turn to the service station to improve access from the highway
- a shared path connection on the eastern side of Mount Lindesay Highway to provide an active transport link across Jimboomba Creek
- an on-road bike path on both sides of the highway
- allowance for the future development of dual right-turn lanes at Camp Cable Road when required.

Site establishment works

Construction works for the project are due to start in January 2020.

Initial works to establish the construction site will include:

- installing temporary project fencing
- establishing worker facilities including temporary buildings, south of the creek on the eastern side of the highway
- service location works
- speed limit reductions and installing traffic barriers on the Mount Lindesay Highway and surrounding streets.

What to expect

Once the construction site has been set up, works will continue in stages.

The first stage of works will include:

- construction of the northbound bridge over Jimboomba Creek
- construction of two northbound lanes including earthworks, drainage installation and constructing pavements.

During construction:

- residents near the work zone may experience increased noise, dust and vibration
- movement of large construction equipment and machinery and use of vehicles and machinery fitted with flashing lights and reversing beepers for safety reasons
- construction traffic entering and exiting work areas and site offices
- some temporary and permanent changes to property access. These will be communicated with residents ahead of any changes being made
- motorists can expect lane closures, reduced speed limits and increased congestion.

Every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts where possible.

Standard work hours and days will be Monday to Saturday, 7am to 5pm.

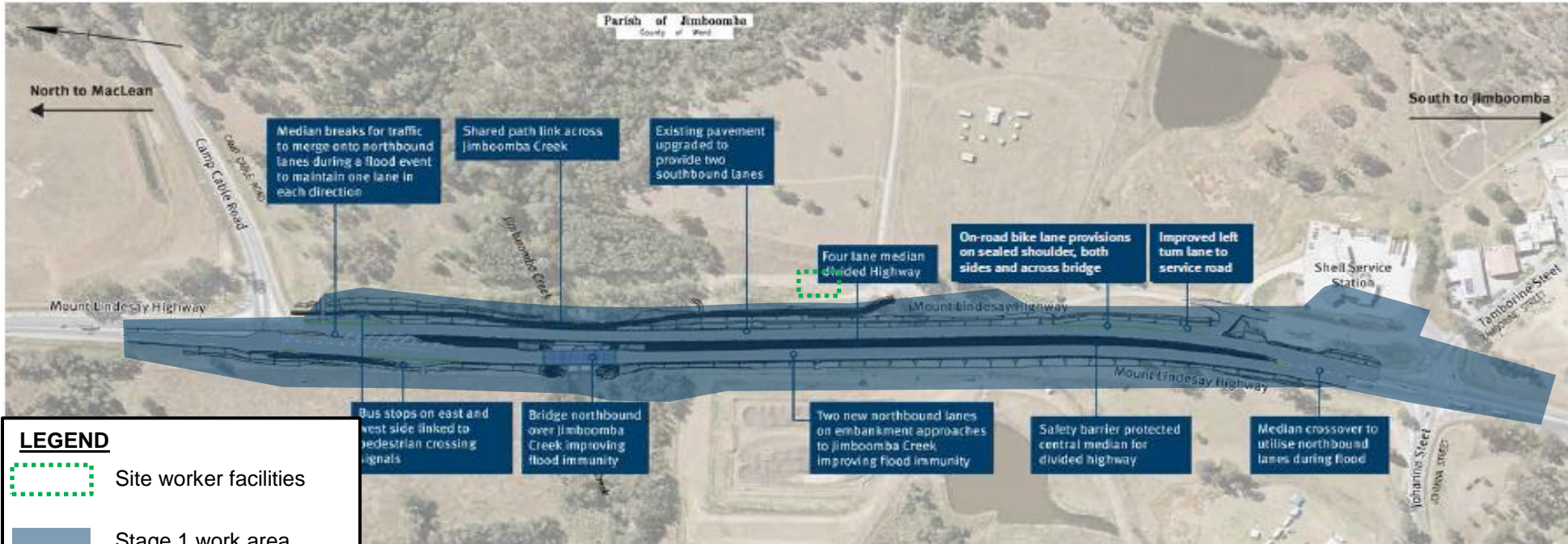
From time to time, work outside of these times may be required for safety reasons or in case of an emergency.

Nightworks may be required late January / February from 7pm to 5am to install traffic barriers, line marking and signage on the Mount Lindesay Highway.
